

Disposal Options for Home Generated Sharps in the City of Aliso Viejo



****Effective September 1, 2008, Senate Bill 1305 prohibits disposal of home generated sharps in solid waste and recycling containers****

"home-generated sharps waste" is defined as hypodermic needles, pen needles, intravenous needles, lancets, and other devices that are used to penetrate the skin for the delivery of medications derived from a household, including a multifamily residence

Mail In - Costs Vary**

Sharps Disposal by Mail System®

City of Aliso Viejo residents are encouraged to call the toll free number below and order the "SHARPS Disposal by Mail System". The system is comprised of a container in which you place your used needles, a government approved return by mail system and instructions for use. When the container is full, it is mailed in the postage pre-paid return box. The waste will then be properly documented and destroyed.
