



## Integrated Waste Management

The State of California's Universal Waste Rule applies to common household hazardous waste that is generated. Pursuant to the Franchise Agreement with CR&R the City of Aliso Viejo will have two Household Hazardous Waste Collection (HHWCC) Events in 2006 (to be announced). If you need to discard something before our Hazardous Waste Collection Event please refer to the website links listed below or call 949-425-2535 for more information.

The following items are considered Universal Waste and should no longer be placed in the trash, but taken to a HHWCC for proper disposal.

- **Batteries** (carbon-zinc and alkaline [AA, AAA, C, D, and 9-volt], rechargeable [nickel metal hydride, lithium ion, and small sealed lead used in security system alarms, computers, and toy vehicles], Mercuric Oxide and Silver Oxide [button-type used in watches, calculators, and hearing aids]). There is a collection box (the Big Green Recycling Box) for small batteries at City Hall for your convenience.
- **Fluorescent Lamps** (tubes and compact types)
- **Mercury Thermometers**
- **Novelty items that contain batteries** (singing greeting cards, flashing athletic shoes, jewelry)
- **Cathode Ray Tubes** (CRTs such as televisions, computer monitors)
- **Consumer Electronic Devices** (flat-panel TVs and monitors, computers (CPUs), keyboards, cell and cordless phones, game consoles, stereos, microwaves, etc. – all items containing circuit boards)

**Effective immediately** the four Household Hazardous Waste Collection Centers (HHWCC's) in Orange County (listed below) are extending the hours of operation and will now be open from 9 am to 3 pm instead of 1 pm to 3 pm.

#### Hazardous Waste Questions

##### Where can I dispose of household hazardous waste?

There are four Household Hazardous Waste collection centers in Orange County. They are located in **Anaheim** – 1071 N. Blue Gum Street, **Huntington Beach** – 17121 Nichols Street, **Irvine** – 6411 Oak Canyon and **San Juan Capistrano** – Prima Deschecha Landfill.

##### How much does it cost to use the HHWCC's?

**Absolutely No Charge!** Orange County residents may dispose of household hazardous waste at the Collection Centers for FREE.

##### What are the operating hours of the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Centers?

All HHW Collection Centers are open Tuesday through Saturday, 9 AM to 3 PM. The centers are closed on rainy days, Christmas, New Years, Thanksgiving and Independence Day.

##### How much paint can I bring to the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center?

You may bring up to 15 gallons or 125 pounds per trip. You may make as many trips as you need.

##### Can I bring hazardous waste from my business to a Household Hazardous Waste Collection Center?

No, businesses must contact a hazardous waste disposal company by checking the telephone directory under the listing "Waste Disposal - Hazardous" or searching the internet at [www.enviroyellowpages.com](http://www.enviroyellowpages.com).

##### What is accepted at the Household Hazardous Waste Collection Centers?
