NOTICE IS HEREBY GIVEN that on Tuesday, January 23, 2007, at 4:00 p.m. (or as soon thereafter as possible) the Development Review Committee of the City of Aliso Viejo will consider the following application:

SPECIAL SIGN PERMIT SSP07-01 FOR PLACEMENT OF A SERIES OF TEMPORARY, FREE-STANDING SIGNS INTENDED TO DRAW ATTENTION TO THE TOWN CENTER AND ADJACENT OFFICE/RESEARCH COMPANIES FOR THE PURPOSE OF PROMOTING ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT THROUGHOUT THE CITY.

THE SIGNS RANGE IN SIZE FROM 54 TO 120 SQ. FT., AND HEIGHTS RANGING FROM 8 FT. TO 9 FT., AND WILL BE LOCATED ON PRIVATE PROPERTY ALONG THE HIGHWAY 73 CORRIDOR FROM ALISO VIEJO PARKWAY NORTH TO PACIFIC PARK. BECAUSE OF THE UNIQUE NATURE OF THE PROPOSED SIGNS, A SPECIAL SIGN PERMIT IS REQUIRED TO APPROVE THIS REQUEST.
