Code Requirements: California Residential Code Section R314 and Senate Bill 745 states in part that existing dwellings shall be provided with smoke and carbon monoxide alarms when alterations, repairs, or additions requiring a permit occur. The alarms shall be equipped with a 10-year life battery in a sealed unit and any unit over 10 years old shall be replaced.

I, the undersigned, hereby certify that I am the owner and occupant of the above referenced property. I further certify that smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are present and functional in all the following locations:

- On the ceiling or upper portion of the wall outside of each area that can be used for sleeping in the immediate vicinity of the sleeping rooms (one smoke and carbon monoxide alarm in each hallway outside of the rooms “can be a combination unit”).
- In each room that can be used for sleeping purposes (smoke alarm only).
- On each level of the home (smoke and carbon monoxide alarm).
- That the smoke and carbon monoxide alarms are less than 10 years old based on the date of manufacture located on the bottom of the alarm.

California Residential Code Section R315 and Senate Bill 183 states in part that carbon monoxide alarm(s) shall be provided when the total cost of repairs, additions or alterations exceeds \$1,000. I certify that carbon monoxide alarms have been installed:

- On every level of the home in a central location.
