
NEW UNIVERSAL WASTE COLLECTION SERVICE

CR&R BEGINS UNIVERSAL WASTE COLLECTION ON APRIL 1, 2008

Due to changes in California Environmental Protection Legislation, certain waste products can NO LONGER be accepted at the landfill or recycling center.

It is important to separate these waste products from your regular trash and recycling containers. The products labeled as Universal Waste (U-Waste) are listed below:

- Batteries (except automobile batteries which must be delivered to a certified hazardous waste center)
- Thermostats
- Fluorescent Tubes
- Cathode Ray Tubes such as televisions and computer monitors
- High Intensity Discharge Lamps such as heat lamps
- Sodium Vapor Lamps such as low light pollution light bulbs
- Aerosol Cans which are not completely empty
- Mercury containing items such as light switches, pressure gauges, thermometers and greeting cards that play music
- Electronic Waste (E-Waste) including but not limited to computers, monitors, cellular telephones, copiers, fax machines, DVD players, VCRs, and televisions
- Prescription and Non-Prescription medications
- Sharps such as syringes and lancets within a one-way protection container



HOW DO I ARRANGE FOR U-WASTE COLLECTION?

Special pickup arrangements must be made by calling CR&R Customer Service at (877) 728-0446. Be certain to provide the Customer Service Representative with the exact items and quantity of each item that will be placed out for collection. The Customer Service Representative will also assist you in preparing the items for collection. Due to environmental regulations, any item not listed on the service order can not be picked up.

WHERE DO YOU PLACE SCHEDULED ITEMS FOR PICKUP?

Once you schedule a U-Waste Collection, place the items that have been called in for pick up near your garage door before 7am on your regular collection day. This will help to keep items out of public areas, provide safe temporary storage and avoid exposure of potentially harmful materials to people and the environment. A CR&R collection specialist will collect the items from the garage door location or the location you request at your time of order and transport the materials to a consolidation facility for transport to recycling centers.

We suggest that you accumulate and store in a safe place in your residence a reasonable quantity of batteries, fluorescent tubes, a full one-way Sharps container and other U-Waste items before arranging for this collection service.

Please note the following collection requirements:

- A minimum number of U-Waste products is required to schedule a special collection service
- "Sharps" must be contained within an approved one-way Sharps Container
- Any prescription medications should have your name removed from the container
